A LOOK AT ADELAIDE

A half day guided tour

Take a look at some of the sights that Adelaide has to offer accompanied by a knowledgeable local guide. This half day tour presents an excellent introduction to the history, background and interesting points of Adelaide.

Highlights include:

- The **city's square mile** with its distinctive square, terraces, parks and gardens, and heritage buildings.
- A look beyond the obvious in **North Terrace**, Adelaide cultural boulevard, with its museums, galleries and courtyards.
- **Montefiore Hill** provides an excellent vantage point to look over the City of Adelaide. Adelaide is recognised as one of the most practical and beautiful cities in the world and the spot from where you can view this panorama and observe Colonel William Light's statue with outstretched arm is known as Light's Vision.
- **St Peters Cathedral**, One of the most historic buildings in Adelaide, this is also a centre for faith and spirituality, music and the arts.

A TASTE OF THE ADELAIDE HILLS

A half day guided tour

Located only 20 minutes from Adelaide's central business district, the Adelaide Hills provide a wonderfully refreshing change from the pace of the city. One visit to the Adelaide Hills and you'll see why this place fuelled the creative fires of so many artists. The picturesque farmlands and charming villages of the Adelaide Hills look like they were meant to be painted.

Highlights include:

- **Mount Lofty Summit**, At 710 metres above sea level and only 15 minutes from the city centre of Adelaide, the Mt Lofty Summit lookout has spectacular panoramic views over Adelaide to the sea.
- **Historic Hahndorf**, One of the Adelaide Hills most famous towns, Hahndorf is Australia's oldest surviving German settlement. There's still a strong German flavour in the town, most evident in the smallgoods outlets and German bakeries that line the main street or you may like to visit the former home and studio of Sir Hans Heysen – The Cedars.
- Beerenberg Farm, from its humble beginnings in the Adelaide Hills, Beerenberg Farm has become a household name in Australia and its delicious products are now found in dozens of countries around the world. All products are made from the company's farm, which has been in the family since 1839, when the Paech family settled in Hahndorf.
